This checklist may be helpful to you when are working on your sustainability project. It clearly shows you all of the elements of the task and will help you to work through each stage without missing anything.

Research (this needs to be written and submitted):	
I have defined sustainability.	
I have described what sustainability looks like locally, nationally AND globally.	
I have listed the earth's natural resources.	
I have defined what a renewable resource is.	
I have defined what a non-renewable resource is.	
I have identified the impact that renewable resources have on society.	
I have identified the impact that non-renewable resources have on society.	
I have explained the responsibility we have to ensure we protect our environment.	
I have answered the bonus question.	
Action Plan:	
I have selected a sustainability issue in my local, national OR global community that I would like to address.	
I have outlined the problem and come up with a solution.	
I have developed an action plan that outlines what I want to achieve and how I will achieve it.	
I have researched who I will need to contact in order to implement my plan.	
I have clearly planned what I will need to say to this person/these people.	
I have contacted the appropriate person/people.	
I have evidence of my communication (email, letter, short notes about a phone conversation)	
I have planned the step by step process of implementing my action plan.	
Reference List	
I have completed the reference list given to me by my teacher.	
I have made useful comments for each resource.	
I have used at least TWO books for my research. (Not just the internet!)	
Presentation:	
I have chosen an interesting and engaging way of presenting my project to my class.	
I have planned what I will share with my class (your research, plan and responses if you have received any)	
I have written my presentation out and practised it, timing it to make sure it goes for 4-5mins.	
I have prepared visuals to make my presentation more interesting.	
I have practised my full presentation in front of a family member.
